



Ergonomics is the study of the "man-machine" interface.

If we consider that many employees today use the car, or a vehicle in order to travel from A to B for work, this vehicle is then a work tool. It is then necessary to ensure that the layout of the vehicle is suitable for the employee.

Anthropometry is a branch of ergonomics concerned with the study and measurement of body dimensions.

A car ergonomic assessment will use anthropometric measurements to establish if the man – vehicle interface is suitably matched.
